At the end of subtitle B of title III, insert the following:

## 1 SEC. 3 . COMPTROLLER GENERAL REPORT ON ENVIRON-2 **MENTAL CLEANUP** OF VIEQUES AND 3 CULEBRA, PUERTO RICO. 4 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Congress that— 5 (1) the Secretary of Defense should explore all 6 7 avenues and alternatives to expedite the ongoing 8 cleanup and environmental restoration process in the 9 former military training sites located on the island-10 municipalities of Vieques and Culebra, Puerto Rico; 11 (2) the Department of Defense should work 12 with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the 13 Fish and Wildlife Service, and the Government of 14 Puerto Rico to ensure the decontamination process 15 is conducted in a manner that causes the least pos-16 sible intrusion on the lives of island residents and

17 minimizes public health risks; and

(3) the Federal Government should collaborate
 with local and private stakeholders to effectively ad dress economic challenges and opportunities in
 Vieques, Culebra, and the adjacent communities of
 the former United States Naval Station Roosevelt
 Roads.

(b) GAO REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after 7 8 the date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General 9 of the United States shall complete a study and submit 10 a report to the congressional defense committees on the 11 status of the Federal cleanup and decontamination process in the island-municipalities of Vieques and Culebra, Puer-12 13 to Rico. The study shall include a comprehensive analysis 14 of the following:

(1) The pace of ongoing cleanup and environmental restoration efforts in the former military
training sites in Vieques and Culebra.

18 (2) Potential challenges and alternatives to ac19 celerate the completion of such efforts, including
20 their associated costs and any impact they might
21 have on the public health and safety of island resi22 dents.
