

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-

**OFFERED BY MS. GOODLANDER OF NEW
HAMPSHIRE**

At the end of subtitle F of title X, add the following
new section:

1 **SEC. 10___. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR MEMBERS**
2 **OF THE ARMED FORCES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are hereby appropriated for
4 fiscal year 2027, out of any money in the Treasury not
5 otherwise appropriated, for any period during which in-
6 terim or full-year appropriations for fiscal year 2027 are
7 not in effect—

8 (1) such sums as are necessary to provide pay
9 and allowances to members of the Armed Forces (as
10 defined in section 101(a)(4) of title 10, United
11 States Code), including reserve components thereof,
12 who perform active service during such period;

13 (2) such sums as are necessary to provide pay
14 and allowances to the civilian personnel of the De-
15 partment of Defense (and the Department of Home-
16 land Security in the case of the Coast Guard) whom
17 the Secretary concerned determines are providing

1 support to members of the Armed Forces described
2 in paragraph (1); and

3 (3) such sums as are necessary to provide pay
4 and allowances to contractors of the Department of
5 Defense (and the Department of Homeland Security
6 in the case of the Coast Guard) whom the Secretary
7 concerned determines are providing support to mem-
8 bers of the Armed Forces described in paragraph
9 (1).

10 (b) TERMINATION.—Appropriations and funds made
11 available and authority granted pursuant to this section
12 shall be available until whichever of the following first oc-
13 curs:

14 (1) The enactment into law of an appropriation
15 (including a continuing appropriation) for any pur-
16 pose for which amounts are made available in sub-
17 section (a).

18 (2) The enactment into law of the applicable
19 regular or continuing appropriations resolution or
20 other Act without any appropriation for such pur-
21 pose.

22 (3) January 1, 2028.

23 (c) SECRETARY CONCERNED DEFINED.—In this sec-
24 tion, the term “Secretary concerned” means—

1 (1) the Secretary of Defense with respect to
2 matters concerning the Department of Defense; and

3 (2) the Secretary of Homeland Security with re-
4 spect to matters concerning the Coast Guard.
