

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3080, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. GOSAR OF ARIZONA

At the end of title I of the bill, add the following:

1 SEC. 139. PROTECTING AMERICANS FROM VIOLENT CRIME.

2 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:

3 (1) The Second Amendment to the Constitution
4 provides that “the right of the people to keep and
5 bear Arms, shall not be infringed”.

6 (2) Section 327.13 of title 36, Code of Federal
7 Regulations, provides that, except in special cir-
8 cumstances, “possession of loaded firearms, ammu-
9 nition, loaded projectile firing devices, bows and ar-
10 rows, crossbows, or other weapons is prohibited” at
11 water resources development projects administered
12 by the Secretary.

13 (3) The regulations described in paragraph (2)
14 prevent individuals complying with Federal and
15 State laws from exercising the Second Amendment
16 rights of the individuals while at the water resources
17 development projects.

18 (4) Federal laws should make it clear that the
19 Second Amendment rights of an individual at a

1 water resources development project should not be
2 infringed.

3 (b) PROTECTING THE RIGHT OF INDIVIDUALS TO
4 BEAR ARMS AT WATER RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT
5 PROJECTS.—The Secretary may not promulgate or en-
6 force any regulation that prohibits an individual from pos-
7 sessed a firearm, including an assembled or functional
8 firearm, at a water resources development project covered
9 under section 327.0 of title 36, Code of Federal Regula-
10 tions (as in effect on the date of enactment of this Act),
11 if—

12 (1) the individual is not otherwise prohibited by
13 law from possessing the firearm; and

14 (2) the possession of the firearm is in compli-
15 ance with the law of the State in which the water
16 resources development project is located.
