AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119–8 OFFERED BY MR. GOTTHEIMER OF NEW JERSEY

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following:

1	SEC. 17 LIMITATION ON TRANSFER OF WEAPONS TO
2	TURKEY.
3	(a) In General.—The President may not transfer
4	or license for export any defense articles or defense serv-
5	ices to the Government of Turkey, or to any agency or
6	instrumentality of Turkey, until the Secretary of State,
7	with the concurrence of the Secretary of Defense, provides
8	to the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate, the
9	Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representa-
10	tives, and the congressional defense committees a report
11	that includes—
12	(1) a detailed description of the steps taken to
13	ensure that Turkey is no longer engaged in repeated
14	violations or threats of violations of the sovereign
15	territory of another member country of the North
16	Atlantic Treaty Organization, major non-NATO al-
17	lies, or the Republic of Cyprus, including by pro-
18	viding political, logistical, or financial support to a
19	United States-designated terrorist organization;

1	(2) a detailed description of the steps taken to
2	prevent Turkey from purchasing defense systems
3	from United States foreign adversaries in direct vio-
4	lation of United States law;
5	(3) a detailed description of the steps taken to
6	prevent the use of United States arms to facilitate
7	the occupation of the Republic of Cyprus and the
8	status of weapons previously transferred to the Gov-
9	ernment of Turkey or armed forces of Turkey which
10	are now located in Cyprus; and
11	(4) a detailed description of any attacks on
12	United States servicemembers or their families and
13	efforts by the Government of Turkey to prevent fu-
14	ture attacks.
15	(b) Briefing.—Upon completion of the report re-
16	quired by subsection (a), and prior to any notification of
17	Congress of the intent to transfer or license for export
18	any defense articles or defense services to the Government
19	of Turkey, the Secretary of State, in coordination with the
20	Secretary of Defense, shall brief the Committee on For-
21	eign Relations of the Senate, the Committee on Foreign
22	Affairs of the House of Representatives, and the congres-
23	sional defense committees on the report.
24	(c) Sunset.—This section shall terminate on the
25	earlier of—

1	(1) the date that is five years after the date of
2	the enactment of this Act; or
3	(2) the date on which the President certifies to
4	such congressional committees that the Government
5	of Turkey is no longer engaged in repeated viola-
6	tions or threats of violations of the sovereign terri-
7	tory of another member country of the North Atlan-
8	tic Treaty Organization, major non-NATO allies, or
9	the Republic of Cyprus.
