

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-**

**33**

**OFFERED BY MR. GOTTHEIMER OF NEW JERSEY**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following:

1 **SEC. 17\_\_ . DISCLOSURE OF FOREIGN FUNDING FOR ELE-**  
2 **MENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS.**

3 (a) DISCLOSURE REQUIRED.—As a condition of re-  
4 ceiving Federal funds, each local educational agency and  
5 private elementary and secondary school shall annually  
6 disclose to the Secretary of Education any funding re-  
7 ceived from a foreign source of concern in an amount  
8 equal to \$10,000 or more, considered alone or in combina-  
9 tion with all other funds received from that foreign source  
10 within a calendar year.

11 (b) ELEMENTS.—Each disclosure report under sub-  
12 section (a) shall include—

13 (1) the amount and type of funding received  
14 from the foreign source of concern;

15 (2) the identity of the foreign source;

16 (3) any contracts or other agreements entered  
17 into with the foreign source;

18 (4) the stated purpose of the funds; and

1           (5) a description of any influence the foreign  
2           source sought to exercise over curriculum, staffing,  
3           or academic affairs.

4           (c) PARENTAL RIGHTS.—A parent of a child attend-  
5           ing a school subject to the requirements of subsection (a)  
6           shall have a right to request and receive copies of any cur-  
7           ricular or professional development materials obtained  
8           using funds provided by a foreign source of concern.

9           (d) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary of Edu-  
10          cation shall make any disclosure reports received under  
11          subsection (a) available on a publicly accessible website of  
12          the Department of Education in searchable electronic for-  
13          mat.

14          (e) ENFORCEMENT.—If the Secretary of Education  
15          determines that a local educational agency or private  
16          school failed to disclose funding received from a foreign  
17          source of concern in violation of subsection (a), the Sec-  
18          retary shall—

19                 (1) provide notice of such determination to the  
20                 agency or school concerned; and

21                 (2) give the agency or school a period of 30  
22                 days to correct such violation before withholding  
23                 Federal funds from that agency or school.

24          (f) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

1           (1) The terms “elementary school”, “local edu-  
2           cational agency”, “secondary school”, and “parent”  
3           have the meanings given those terms in section 8101  
4           of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of  
5           1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).

6           (2) The term “foreign source of concern”  
7           means—

8                   (A) the People’s Republic of China;

9                   (B) the Russian Federation;

10                  (C) the Islamic Republic of Iran;

11                  (D) the Democratic People’s Republic of  
12           North Korea;

13                  (E) Cuba;

14                  (F) Venezuela;

15                  (G) Qatar;

16                  (H) Turkey;

17                  (I) a foreign terrorist organization; or

18                  (J) any individual or entity controlled by  
19           or acting on behalf of a country or organization  
20           specified in subparagraphs (A) through (I).
