

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. GOTTHEIMER OF NEW JERSEY

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, insert the following:

1 SEC. 17 ____ . ARMS DELIVERY QUEUE REPORT.

2 Section 25 of the Arms Export Control Act (22
3 U.S.C. 2765) is amended—

4 (1) by redesignating subsections (b), (c),
5 (d)(relating to “cash flow financing” defined),
6 (d)(relating to transmission of information to Con-
7 gress), and (e) as subsections (c) through (g), re-
8 spectively; and

9 (2) by inserting the following new subsection
10 after subsection (a):

11 “(b) ANNUAL ARMS DELIVERY QUEUE REPORT.—

12 “(1) REPORT REQUIRED.—No later than Feb-
13 ruary 1 of each year, the President shall submit to
14 the appropriate congressional committees a report
15 on arms delivery queues for Foreign Military Sales
16 cases with a total contract value exceeding
17 \$200,000,000 in which a foreign state that the
18 President determines faces a significant security
19 threat is a direct customer.

1 “(2) CONTENT.—The report required by para-
2 graph (1) shall—

3 “(A) for each foreign military sales case in
4 the foreign country designated by the President
5 as a customer, list all other purchaser countries
6 ahead of that customer in the production or de-
7 livery queue for the same weapon system or
8 munition, and provide a justification for that
9 sequencing decision;

10 “(B) detail any adjustments made to deliv-
11 ery queues during the preceding year to expe-
12 dite delivery to the foreign country so des-
13 igned by the President, including the specific
14 authority under which such adjustments were
15 made and the impact on other customers in the
16 queue;

17 “(C) provide the estimated dates of initial
18 and full delivery completion for each foreign
19 military sales case described in subparagraph
20 (A) and identify any changes from the esti-
21 mated delivery dates in the prior year’s report,
22 with an explanation of the reasons for any slip-
23 page;

24 “(D) identify specific actions taken during
25 the preceding year, and additional actions avail-

1 able in the coming year, to expedite delivery of
2 foreign military sales cases described in sub-
3 paragraph (A), including production rate in-
4 creases, priority allocation of components, and
5 use of defense articles and services;

6 “(E) describe the steps taken to ameliorate
7 the concerns of any foreign country subject to
8 delivery completion delays, including increased
9 bilateral military exercises, the deployment or
10 stationing of United States forces, or the provi-
11 sion of interim capabilities until the foreign
12 military sales case is fully delivered; and

13 “(F) identify specific legislative authorities
14 or appropriations that Congress could provide
15 to accelerate delivery of the foreign military
16 sales cases described in subparagraph (A), in-
17 cluding funding for production line expansion.”.
