Page 133, after line 21, insert the following:

## 1SEC. 208. H-2B VISA PILOT PROGRAM FOR DISASTER RE-2SPONSE.

3 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law and subject to the limitations under sub-4 5 section (b), not later than 18 months after the date of 6 enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Secu-7 rity, in consultation with the Secretary of Labor and the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management 8 9 Agency, shall establish through regulation a six year pilot program to facilitate the use of H-2B workers to perform 10 11 labor or services necessary to recover and rebuild a community affected by a Federally-declared disaster, without 12 13 regard to the numerical cap on H2-B workers.

14 (b) LIMITATION.—

(1) NO IMPACT ON AMERICAN JOBS.—The Secretary of Homeland Security may only issue H-2B
visas without regard to the numerical cap under subsection (a) in excess of the domestic capability to
perform labor or services necessary to recover and

rebuild a community affected by a Federally-de clared disaster.

3 (2)INITIAL OFFER OF EMPLOYMENT RE-QUIRED.—No alien may be granted a H-2B visa 4 5 without regard to the numerical cap without an ini-6 tial valid offer of employment to perform labor or 7 services necessary to recover and rebuild a commu-8 nity affected by a Federally-declared disaster.

9 (c) ENFORCEMENT.—The Secretary of Labor shall be 10 responsible for conducting investigations and random audits of employers to ensure compliance with the employ-11 ment-related requirements under subsection (b). The Sec-12 13 retary of Labor shall have the authority to collect reasonable civil penalties for violations, which shall be utilized 14 15 by the Secretary of Labor for the administration and enforcement of the provisions of this section. 16

(d) REPORT.—Not later than six months before the
end of the third fiscal year of pilot program established
under subsection (a) the Secretary of Homeland Security,
in consultation with the Secretary of Labor and the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency, shall report to Congress on the pilot program established under subsection (a).
