

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
FOR H.R. 4909
OFFERED BY MR. GRAYSON OF FLORIDA**

At the end of title VII, add the following new section:

**1 SEC. 843. DEBARMENT REQUIRED OF PERSONS CONVICTED
2 OF FRAUDULENT USE OF “MADE IN AMER-
3 ICA” LABELS.**

4 (a) DEBARMENT REQUIRED.—Subsection (a) of sec-
5 tion 2410f of title 10, United States Code, is amended
6 by striking “the Secretary shall” and all that follows
7 through the period and inserting “the person shall be
8 debarred from contracting with the Department of De-
9 fense unless the Secretary waives the debarment under
10 subsection (b).”.

11 (b) WAIVER AUTHORITY AND NOTIFICATION RE-
12 QUIREMENT.—Section 2410f of such title is further
13 amended—

14 (1) by redesignating subsection (b) as sub-
15 section (d); and

16 (2) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-
17 lowing new subsections:

1 “(b) WAIVER FOR NATIONAL SECURITY.—The Sec-
2 retary may waive a debarment required by subsection (a)
3 if the Secretary determines that the exercise of such a
4 waiver would be in the national security interests of the
5 United States.

6 “(c) NOTIFICATION.—The Secretary shall notify the
7 congressional defense committees annually, not later than
8 January 31 of each year, through January 31, 2021, of
9 any exercise of the waiver authority under subsection
10 (b).”.

11 (c) TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.—Section 2410f of
12 such title is further amended—

13 (1) in subsection (a), by inserting “‘DEBAR-
14 MENT REQUIRED.—” after “(a)” ; and

15 (2) in subsection (d), as redesignated by sub-
16 section (b), by inserting “DEFINITION.—” before
17 “In this section”.
