

**AMENDMENT TO THE SENATE AMENDMENT TO H.  
CON. RES 71  
OFFERED BY MR. GROTHMAN OF WISCONSIN**

Section 2001 is amended to read as follows:

1 **SEC. 2001. RECONCILIATION IN THE SENATE.**

2 (a) SUBMISSIONS PROVIDING FOR RECONCILI-  
3 ATION.—Not later than November 13, 2017, the commit-  
4 tees named in subsection (b) shall submit their rec-  
5 ommendations on changes in laws within their jurisdic-  
6 tions to the Committee on the Budget that would achieve  
7 the specified change in the deficit for the period of fiscal  
8 years 2018 through 2027.

9 (b) INSTRUCTIONS.—

10 (1) COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.—The Committee  
11 on Finance of the Senate shall report changes in  
12 laws within its jurisdiction that increase the deficit  
13 by not more than \$1,434,000,000,000 for the period  
14 of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

15 (2) COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND NATURAL RE-  
16 SOURCES.—The Committee on Energy and Natural  
17 Resources of the Senate shall report changes in laws  
18 within its jurisdiction to reduce the deficit by not

1 less than \$5,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal  
2 years 2018 through 2027.

3 (3) COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE, NUTRITION,  
4 AND FORESTRY.—The Committee on Agriculture,  
5 Nutrition, and Forestry of the Senate shall report  
6 changes in laws within its jurisdiction to reduce the  
7 deficit by not less than \$10,000,000,000 for the pe-  
8 riod of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

9 (4) COMMITTEE ON ARMED SERVICES.—The  
10 Committee on Armed Services of the Senate shall re-  
11 port changes in laws within its jurisdiction to reduce  
12 the deficit by not less than \$1,000,000,000 for the  
13 period of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

14 (5) COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC  
15 WORK.—The Committee on Environment and Public  
16 Work of the Senate shall report changes in laws  
17 within its jurisdiction to reduce the deficit by not  
18 less than \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal  
19 years 2018 through 2027.

20 (6) COMMITTEE ON HEALTH, EDUCATION,  
21 LABOR, AND PENSIONS.—The Committee on Health,  
22 Education, Labor, and Pensions of the Senate shall  
23 report changes in laws within its jurisdiction to re-  
24 duce the deficit by not less than \$39,000,000,000  
25 for the period of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

1           (7) COMMITTEE ON HOMELAND SECURITY AND  
2 GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS.—The Committee on  
3 Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the  
4 Senate shall report changes in laws within its juris-  
5 diction to reduce the deficit by not less than  
6 \$35,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2018  
7 through 2027.

8           (8) COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY.—The Com-  
9 mittee on Judiciary of the Senate shall report  
10 changes in laws within its jurisdiction to reduce the  
11 deficit by not less than \$45,000,000,000 for the pe-  
12 riod of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

13           (9) COMMITTEE ON VETERANS' AFFAIRS.—The  
14 Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate shall  
15 report changes in laws within its jurisdiction to re-  
16 duce the deficit by not less than \$1,000,000,000 for  
17 the period of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

18           (c) SUBMISSIONS PROVIDING FOR RECONCILI-  
19 ATION.—Not later than November 13, 2017, the commit-  
20 tees named in subsection (d) shall submit their rec-  
21 ommendations on changes in laws within their jurisdic-  
22 tions to the Committee on the Budget that would achieve  
23 the specified change in the deficit for the period of fiscal  
24 years 2018 through 2027.

25           (d) INSTRUCTIONS.—

1           (1) COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE.—The Com-  
2       mittee on Agriculture shall submit changes in laws  
3       within its jurisdiction sufficient to reduce the deficit  
4       by \$10,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years  
5       2018 through 2027.

6           (2) COMMITTEE ON ARMED SERVICES.—The  
7       Committee on Armed Services shall submit changes  
8       in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to reduce the  
9       deficit by \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal  
10      years 2018 through 2027.

11          (3) COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND THE  
12      WORKFORCE.—The Committee on Education and  
13      the Workforce shall submit changes in laws within  
14      its jurisdiction sufficient to reduce the deficit by  
15      \$20,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2018  
16      through 2027.

17          (4) COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND COMMERCE.—  
18      The Committee on Energy and Commerce shall sub-  
19      mit changes in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient  
20      to reduce the deficit by \$20,000,000,000 for the pe-  
21      riod of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

22          (5) COMMITTEE ON FINANCIAL SERVICES.—The  
23      Committee on Financial Services shall submit  
24      changes in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to

1       reduce the deficit by \$14,000,000,000 for the period  
2       of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

3               (6) COMMITTEE ON HOMELAND SECURITY.—

4       The Committee on Homeland Security shall submit  
5       changes in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to  
6       reduce the deficit by \$3,000,000,000 for the period  
7       of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

8               (7) COMMITTEE ON THE JUDICIARY.—The

9       Committee on the Judiciary shall submit changes in  
10       laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to reduce the  
11       deficit by \$45,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal  
12       years 2018 through 2027.

13              (8) COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES.—

14       The Committee on Natural Resources of the House  
15       of Representatives shall submit changes in laws  
16       within its jurisdiction to reduce the deficit by not  
17       less than \$5,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal  
18       years 2018 through 2027.

19              (9) COMMITTEE ON OVERSIGHT AND GOVERN-

20       MENT REFORM.—The Committee on Oversight and  
21       Government Reform shall submit changes in laws  
22       within its jurisdiction sufficient to reduce the deficit  
23       by \$32,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years  
24       2018 through 2027.

1           (10) COMMITTEE ON VETERANS' AFFAIRS.—

2           The Committee on Veterans' Affairs shall submit  
3           changes in laws within its jurisdiction sufficient to  
4           reduce the deficit by \$1,000,000,000 for the period  
5           of fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

6           (11) COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS.—The

7           Committee on Ways and Means of the House of  
8           Representatives shall submit changes in laws within  
9           its jurisdiction that increase the deficit by not more  
10          than \$1,448,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal  
11          years 2018 through 2027.
