

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 467, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. GROTHMAN OF WISCONSIN**

Redesignate sections 2 through 6 as sections 101 through 105, respectively.

Insert before section 101, as redesignated, the following:

1 **TITLE I—HALT FENTANYL**

On page 19, lines 6, 7, and 24, page 20, line 1, and page 21, lines 4, 5, 7, and 11, strike “this Act” each place it appears and insert “this title”.

At the end of the bill, add the following:

5 **SEC. 201. AMENDMENTS TO THE CONTROLLED SUB-**
6 **STANCES ACT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 401(b)(1) of the Con-
8 trolled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 841(b)(1)), as amend-
9 ed, is further amended—

10 (1) in subparagraph (A)(vi)—

11 (A) by striking “400” and inserting “5”;

1 (B) by striking “100” and inserting
2 “0.05”; and

3 (C) by inserting “scheduled or unsched-
4 uled” before “analogue of”; and

5 (2) in subparagraph (B)(vi)—

6 (A) by striking “40” and inserting “0.5”;

7 (B) by striking “10” and inserting
8 “0.005”; and

9 (C) by inserting “scheduled or unsched-
10 uled” before “analogue of”.

11 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
12 this section shall apply to an offense occurring on or after
13 the date of enactment of this section.

14 **SEC. 202. AMENDMENTS TO THE CONTROLLED SUB-**
15 **STANCES IMPORT AND EXPORT ACT.**

16 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 1010(b) of the Controlled
17 Substances Import and Export Act (21 U.S.C. 960(b)),
18 as amended, is further amended—

19 (1) in paragraph (1)(F)—

20 (A) by striking “400” and inserting “5”;

21 (B) by striking “100” and inserting
22 “0.05”; and

23 (C) by inserting “scheduled or unsched-
24 uled” before “analogue of”;

25 (2) in paragraph (2)(F)—

1 (A) by striking “40” and inserting “0.5”;

2 (B) by striking “10” and inserting
3 “0.005”; and

4 (C) by inserting “scheduled or unsched-
5 uled” before “analogue of”; and

6 (3) by adding at the end the following:

7 “(8) In the case of a violation under subsection
8 (a) of this section involving a mixture or substance
9 containing a detectable amount of N-phenyl-N-[1-(2-
10 phenylethyl)-4-piperidinyl] propanamide or a mixture
11 or substance containing a detectable amount of any
12 analogue of N-phenyl-N-[1-(2-phenylethyl)-4-
13 piperidinyl] propanamide, in which the substance
14 was imported along the United States international
15 border with Mexico, the person committing such a
16 violation shall be sentenced to a term of imprison-
17 ment of not less than 20 years and not more than
18 life imprisonment and if death or serious bodily in-
19 jury results from the use of such substance shall be
20 sentenced to life imprisonment.”.

21 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
22 this section shall apply to an offense occurring on or after
23 the date of enactment of this section.
