At the end of subtitle E of title XXVIII, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____.** **QUARTERLY REPORT ON INFILTRATIONS OF**
2 **CERTAIN DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE PROP-**
3 **ERTY BY FOREIGN ACTORS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not less frequently than quar-
5 terly, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the appro-
6 priate congressional committees a report on instances of
7 infiltration, or attempted infiltration, of a military instal-
8 lation, facility, or real property under the jurisdiction of
9 the Department of Defense by a foreign actor during the
10 period covered by the report.

11 (b) **ELEMENTS.**—Each report required by subsection
12 (a) shall include—

13 (1) a summary of each instance of infiltration
14 or attempted infiltration;

15 (2) an identification of the foreign actor the
16 Secretary determines is responsible for such infiltra-
17 tion or attempted infiltration; and

1 (3) with respect to each foreign actor included
2 in such report, an statement of—

3 (A) immigration status, if any;

4 (B) country of origin;

5 (C) method and date of entry into the
6 United States, if known;

7 (D) criminal background, if known; and

8 (E) any other information obtained during
9 the applicable Department of Defense investiga-
10 tion that the Secretary of Defense determines
11 appropriate.

12 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

13 (1) The term “appropriate congressional com-
14 mittees” means—

15 (A) the Committees on Armed Services of
16 the House of Representatives and the Senate

17 (B) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of
18 the House of Representatives;

19 (C) the Committee on Foreign Relations of
20 the Senate;

21 (D) the Committee on Homeland Security
22 of the House of Representatives;

23 (E) the Committee on Homeland Security
24 and Governmental Relations of the Senate;

1 (F) the Select Committee on Intelligence of
2 the Senate;

3 (G) the Permanent Select Committee on
4 Intelligence of the House of Representatives;
5 and

6 (H) the Committee on Oversight and Ac-
7 countability of the House of Representatives.

8 (2) The term “foreign actor” means an indi-
9 vidual who is not a citizen or national of the United
10 States.

11 (3) The term “infiltration” includes, with re-
12 spect to a military installation, facility, or real prop-
13 erty under the jurisdiction of the Department of De-
14 fense, unauthorized photo or video recording.
