AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–10 OFFERED BY MR. GALLAGHER OF WISCONSIN

At end of subtitle A of title XIII, add the following:

1	SEC REPORT ON DEFENSE SUPPORT FOR TAIWAN.
2	(a) In General.—Not later than 180 days after the
3	date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of De-
4	fense, in consultation with the Secretary of State, shall
5	submit to the appropriate committees of Congress a report
6	containing an evaluation of the Foreign Military Sales
7	(FMS) processes across all military services for the provi-
8	sion of defense articles, defense services, and training to
9	Taiwan pursuant to the Taiwan Relations Act (22 U.S.C.
10	3301 et seq.).
11	(b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—Such report shall
12	contain the following:
13	(1) A description of price and availability data
14	with respect to the provision of defense articles, de-
15	fense services, and training requested by Taiwan
16	during the 2-year period preceding the report.
17	(2) A description of timelines from price and
18	availability data requested to price and availability
19	data provided to Taiwan of articles, services, and
20	training described in paragraph (1), including an

1	identification of the specific service lead associated
2	with the provision of such articles, services, and
3	training.
4	(3) A description of when articles, services, and
5	training described in paragraph (1) were provided to
6	the Department of State for FMS authorization.
7	(4) An evaluation of military training activities
8	conducted with Taiwan during the 2-year period pre-
9	ceding the report, including—
10	(A) the objectives of such training activi-
11	ties;
12	(B) funding authority, unless national
13	funds were applied; and
14	(C) an evaluation of the effectiveness of
15	such training activities, including the strengths
16	and weaknesses in Taiwan's capacity to absorb
17	the training provided.
18	(5) A description of the articles, services, and
19	training described in paragraph (1) planned to be
20	provided to Taiwan during the 1-year period after
21	the period covered by the report.
22	(6) A description of the timeframe from De-
23	partment of State authorization to Taiwan signature
24	on the Letter of Offer and Acceptance of articles,
25	services, and training described in paragraph (1)

1	and information on delays in concluding a Letter of
2	Offer and Acceptance.
3	(7) A description of timelines the Department
4	of Defense took to work with United States industry
5	in entering into contracts associated articles, serv-
6	ices, and training described in paragraph (1), includ-
7	ing a description of the average timeframes for Let-
8	ters of Offer and Acceptance.
9	(8) A description of the timeliness of Depart-
10	ment of Defense components' reporting of deliveries
11	articles, services, and training described in para-
12	graph (1).
13	(c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
14	may include a classified annex.
15	(d) Appropriate Committees of Congress De-
16	FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate commit-
17	tees of Congress' means—
18	(1) the Committee on Armed Services and the
19	Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-
20	resentatives; and
21	(2) the Committee on Armed Services and the
22	Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate.
