

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–10**

**OFFERED BY MS. GARCIA OF TEXAS**

At the appropriate place in subtitle A of title XII,  
insert the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . GENDER ANALYSIS IN FOREIGN TRAINING PRO-**  
2 **GRAMS.**

3 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-  
4 gress that the President should encourage the increased  
5 participation of women in existing programs funded by the  
6 United States Government that provide training to foreign  
7 nationals regarding law enforcement, the rule of law, or  
8 professional military education, and should expand and  
9 apply gender analysis to improve program design and im-  
10 plementation.

11 (b) GENDER ANALYSIS OF INTERNATIONAL TRAIN-  
12 ING PROGRAMS.—The Secretary of Defense, in coordina-  
13 tion with the Secretary of State and the heads of other  
14 relevant Federal departments, shall conduct a gender  
15 analysis of International Education and Training pro-  
16 grams offered to allied and partner forces to ensure the  
17 programs are equitable and address issues experienced by  
18 all participants.

1           (c) GENDER ANALYSIS TRAINING.—The Secretary of  
2 Defense, in coordination with the Secretary of State, shall  
3 develop and include gender analysis training to be included  
4 in the International Education and Training Programs at  
5 United States military schools and training institutions.

6           (d) BRIEFING REQUIRED.—No later than two years  
7 after enactment of this act, the Secretary of Defense, in  
8 coordination with the Secretary of State, shall brief the  
9 appropriate congressional committees on the Department  
10 of Defense and Department of State’s actions and  
11 progress in implementing the requirements under sub-  
12 section (b) and subsection (c).

13           (e) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-  
14 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-  
15 sional committees” means—

16                 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the  
17                 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-  
18                 resentatives; and

19                 (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the  
20                 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate.

21           (f) GENDER ANALYSIS DEFINED.—In this section,  
22 the term “gender analysis” has the meaning given such  
23 term in section 3 of the Women’s Entrepreneurship and  
24 Economic Empowerment Act (22 U.S.C. 2151–2).
