Page 947, after line 7, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 60 ____ . MULTIMODAL PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT**

2 **REPORT TO CONGRESS.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor-
5 tation shall submit to the appropriate committees of Con-
6 gress and make available to the public on a Department
7 of Transportation website a report on the efforts by the
8 Department of Transportation to promote the planning
9 and development of multimodal transit facilities.

10 (b) CONTENTS.—The report required under sub-
11 section (a) shall include—

12 (1) a 10-year roadmap for how the Department
13 intends to promote the planning and development of
14 multimodal transit facilities, including transit facili-
15 ties that incorporate advanced air, maritime, rail,
16 subterranean, and surface mobility;

17 (2) an evaluation of whether and how activities
18 related to the planning and development of

1 multimodal transit facilities are eligible under exist-
2 ing formula and discretionary programs, including—

3 (A) Better Utilizing Investments to Lever-
4 age Development (BUILD) grants;

5 (B) Advanced Transportation and Conges-
6 tion Management Technologies Deployment
7 (ATCMT) grants;

8 (C) Transit-Oriented Development Plan-
9 ning (TOD Planning) grants; and

10 (D) Railroad Rehabilitation and Improve-
11 ment Financing Program (RRIF) grants;

12 (3) an evaluation of whether the existing for-
13 mula and discretionary programs identified in para-
14 graph (2) are adequate and appropriate to prevent
15 silos and support the Department’s roadmap for
16 multimodal transit facilities developed under para-
17 graph (1); and

18 (4) recommendations to Congress on where the
19 Department needs additional authority or appropria-
20 tion to ensure the efficient planning and develop-
21 ment of multimodal transit facilities.

22 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the following defi-
23 nitions apply:

24 (1) MULTIMODAL TRANSIT FACILITIES.—The
25 term “multimodal transit facilities” means a transit

1 facility that connects two or more transit modes in
2 one facility.

3 (2) APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES.—The term
4 “appropriate committees” means the Committee on
5 Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of
6 Representatives, the Committee on Appropriations of
7 the House of Representatives, the Committee on
8 Commerce, Science and Transportation of the Sen-
9 ate, the Committee on Environment and Public
10 Works of the Senate, and the Committee on Appro-
11 priations of the Senate.
