## OFFERED BY MR. KEATING OF MASSACHUSETTS

At the end of subtitle C of title XVIII, add the following new section:

9	(2) stand outraged by actions taken by Russian
10	Armed Forces, Government, and their proxies to re-
11	move Ukrainian children from their homes and forc-
12	ibly integrate them into Russian society;
13	(3) condemn the ongoing, unlawful, and system-
14	atic deportation, forcible transfer, and "re-edu-
15	cation" of Ukrainian children from occupied terri-
16	tories of Ukraine to the Russian Federation and
17	within occupied territories of Ukraine under the di-
18	rection of Vladimir Putin and Maria Lvova-Belova;

(4) recognize the devastating psychological, in tergenerational harm and trauma caused to Ukrain ian parents, families, and communities by the forc ible removal of their children and to the Ukrainian
 children separated from their families and commu nities;

7 (5) support the decision of the International 8 Criminal Court to issue arrest warrants for Vladimir 9 Putin, President of the Russian Federation, and 10 Maria Lvova-Belova, Commissioner for Children's 11 Rights in the Office of the President of the Russian 12 Federation, for committing war crimes related to the 13 unlawful deportation of children from occupied areas 14 of Ukraine to the Russian Federation and within oc-15 cupied territories of Ukraine;

(6) call for the Russian Federation to immediately reveal any existing records of the deportation
of children and adoption of deported children to
Ukrainian authorities;

20 (7) call for the Russian Federation to imme21 diately return all deported Ukrainian children back
22 to their homes in Ukraine so they can be reunited
23 with their families and communities;

(8) condemn the Russian Federation for allatrocity crimes and the gross violations of human

rights it has committed in Ukraine such as targeting
 civilians, destroying critical civilian infrastructure re lated to energy and health care, and using torture
 and sexual violence as weapons of war; and

5 (9) call on President Biden to direct all depart-6 ments and agencies to support the International 7 Criminal Court's investigation and prosecution of 8 atrocity crimes committed in Ukraine, including 9 those related to the Russian Federation's unlawful 10 transfer and deportation of children.
