

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
119-33
OFFERED BY MR. HARRIGAN OF NORTH
CAROLINA

At the end of subtitle C of title XXVIII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 28___ . PROHIBITION ON USE OF AUTOMATED SPEED**
2 **ENFORCEMENT CAMERAS ON MILITARY IN-**
3 **STALLATIONS.**

4 Section 2661 of title 10, United States Code, is
5 amended by inserting at the end the following new sub-
6 section:

7 “(e) PROHIBITION ON USE OF AUTOMATED SPEED
8 ENFORCEMENT CAMERAS.—(1) Notwithstanding any
9 other provision of law, no Federal funds may be used by
10 the Secretary of Defense to purchase, install, operate,
11 maintain, or contract for the operation of an automated
12 speed enforcement camera system on a military installa-
13 tion.

14 “(2) By not later than 180 days after the date of
15 the enactment of this subsection, the Secretary shall en-
16 sure that any automated speed enforcement camera sys-
17 tem in operation on a military installation as of the date

1 of the enactment of this section is decommissioned and
2 removed.

3 “(3) Nothing in this subsection may be construed
4 to—

5 “(A) limit the authority of an installation com-
6 mander to enforce posted speed limits on the mili-
7 tary installation under the jurisdiction of the com-
8 mander through means other than automated speed
9 enforcement cameras; or

10 “(B) affect the use of any camera or photo-
11 graphic device for purposes of security, access con-
12 trol, force protection, or criminal investigation, so
13 long as such camera or photographic device is not
14 primarily used for speed enforcement.

15 “(4) In this subsection:

16 “(A) The term ‘automated speed enforcement
17 camera system’ means any system that uses a photo-
18 graphic, video, or other electronic device to—

19 “(i) automatically detect and record the
20 speed of a motor vehicle; and

21 “(ii) generate a record of any vehicle trav-
22 eling in excess of a posted speed limit.

1 “(B) The term ‘military installation’ has the
2 meaning given such term in section 2801 of this
3 title.”.
