At the end of subtitle G of title X, add the following:

4	(1) FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES.—The term
5	"flag of the United States" has the meaning given
6	the term in section 700(b) of title 18, United States
7	Code.
8	(2) PUBLIC BUILDING.—
9	(A) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in
10	subparagraph (B), the term "public building"
11	has the meaning given the term in section
12	3301(a) of title 40, United States Code.
13	(B) INCLUSION.—The term "public build-
14	ing" includes—
15	(i) a military installation (as defined
16	in section 2801(c) of title 10, United
17	States Code); and
18	(ii) any embassy or consulate of the
19	United States.

1 (b) PROHIBITIONS.—Notwithstanding any other pro-2 vision of law and except as provided in subsection (c), no 3 flag that is not the flag of the United States may be flown, 4 draped, or otherwise displayed— 5 (1) on the exterior of a public building; or 6 (2) in the hallway of a public building. 7 (c) EXCEPTIONS.—The prohibitions under subsection 8 (b) shall not apply to— 9 (1) a National League of Families POW/MIA 10 flag (as designated by section 902 of title 36, United 11 States Code); 12 (2) any flag that represents the nation of a vis-13 iting diplomat; 14 (3) the State flag of the State represented by 15 a member of Congress, outside or within the office 16 of the member; 17 (4) in the case of a military installation, any 18 flag that represents a unit or branch of the Armed 19 Forces; 20 (5) in the case of a religious liturgy or cere-21 mony at a military installation or facility, any flag 22 that represents a religious organization or church 23 that is covered by section 501(c)(3) of the Internal 24 Revenue Code of 1986 and exempt from tax under 25 section 501(a) of such Code;

(6) any flag that represents an Indian Tribe (as
defined in section 4 of the Indian Self-Determination
and Education Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 5304)); or
(7) any flag that represents the State, territory,
county, city, or local jurisdiction in which the public
building is located.
