

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3351, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MRS. HARTZLER OF MISSOURI**

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert  
the following:

1       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. None of the funds made available by this  
2 act may be used to modify or change the following laws:

3           (1) The Act entitled “An Act For the suppres-  
4 sion of prostitution in the District of Columbia”, ap-  
5 proved August 15, 1935 (49 Stat. 651; sec. 22-2701  
6 et seq., D.C. Official Code).

7           (2) Section 2 of the Control of Prostitution and  
8 Sale of Controlled Substances in Public Places  
9 Criminal Control Act of 1981, effective December  
10 10, 1981 (D.C. Law 4-57; sec. 22-2701.01, D.C. Of-  
11 ficial Code).

12           (3) Section 3(a) of the Act entitled “An Act in  
13 relation to pandering, to define and prohibit the  
14 same and to provide for the punishment thereof”,  
15 approved June 25, 1910 (36 Stat. 833; sec. 22-  
16 2707(a), D.C. Official Code).

17           (4) Section 1(a) of the Act entitled “An Act To  
18 enjoin and abate houses of lewdness, assignation,  
19 and prostitution; to declare the same to be

1 nuisances; to enjoin the person or persons who con-  
2 duct or maintain the same and the owner or agent  
3 of any building used for such purpose; and to assess  
4 a tax against the person maintaining said nuisance  
5 and against the building and owner thereof”, ap-  
6 proved February 7, 1914 (38 Stat. 280; sec. 22-  
7 2713(a), D.C. Official Code).

8 (5) Section 1 of the Act entitled “An Act To  
9 confer concurrent jurisdiction on the police court of  
10 the District of Columbia in certain cases, approved  
11 July 16, 1912” (37 Stat.192; sec. 22-2722, D.C. Of-  
12 ficial Code).
