

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4182, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. HASTINGS OF FLORIDA**

Page 3, line 18, strike “The length” and insert “Except as provided for in paragraph (2), the length”.

Page 4, after line 8, insert the following (and redesignate accordingly):

1       “(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), in the case of  
2 an individual who is a veteran, as that term is defined  
3 in section 2108(1), the length of a probationary period es-  
4 tablished under paragraph (1) or (2) of subsection (a)  
5 shall—

6               “(A) with respect to a position occupied by such  
7 an individual that requires formal training, begin on  
8 the date of appointment to the position and end on  
9 the date that is 1 year after the date on which such  
10 formal training is completed;

11               “(B) with respect to a position occupied by  
12 such an individual that requires a license, begin on  
13 the date of appointment to the position and end on  
14 the date that is 1 year after the date on which such  
15 license is granted; and

1           “(C) with respect to a position occupied by such  
2           an individual that is not covered by subparagraph  
3           (A) or (B), be a period of 1 year beginning on the  
4           date of the appointment to the position.

Page 4, line 9, strike “paragraph (1)” and insert  
“this subsection”.
