

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 842
OFFERED BY MR. HERN OF OKLAHOMA

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. ____.** **ENACTMENT OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS.**

2 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The provisions of the following
3 Executive Orders are enacted into law:

4 (1) Executive Order 13836 (83 Fed. Reg.
5 25329; relating to Developing Efficient, Effective,
6 and Cost-Reducing Approaches To Federal Sector
7 Collective Bargaining (May 25, 2018)), as in effect
8 on the date of enactment of this Act.

9 (2) Executive Order 13837 (83 Fed. Reg.
10 25335; relating to Ensuring Transparency, Account-
11 ability, and Efficiency in Taxpayer-Funded Union
12 Time Use (May 25, 2018)), as in effect on the date
13 of enactment of this Act.

14 (3) Executive Order 13839 (83 Fed. Reg.
15 25343; relating to Promoting Accountability and
16 Streamlining Removal Procedures Consistent With
17 Merit System Principles (May 25, 2018)), as in ef-
18 fect on the date of enactment of this Act.

19 (4) Executive Order 13957 (85 Fed. Reg.
20 67631; relating to Creating Schedule F in the Ex-

1 cepted Service (October 21, 2020)), as in effect on
2 the date of enactment of this Act.

3 (b) PUBLICATION.—In publishing this Act in slip
4 form and in the United States Statutes at Large pursuant
5 to section 112 of title 1, United States Code, the Archivist
6 of the United States shall include after the date of ap-
7 proval at the end an appendix setting forth the text of
8 the Executive Orders referred to in subsection (a) (as in
9 effect on the date of enactment of this Act).
