## Amendment to Rules Committee Print 117-4 Offered by Mr. Hern of Oklahoma

Add at the end of the bill the following:

1 SEC. 314. CITIZENSHIP AT BIRTH FOR CERTAIN PERSONS 2 BORN IN THE UNITED STATES. 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 301 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1401) is amended— 4 (1) by inserting "(a) IN GENERAL.—" before 5 6 "The following"; 7 (2) by redesignating subsections (a) through (h) 8 as paragraphs (1) through (8), respectively; and 9 (3) by adding at the end the following: 10 "(b) DEFINITION.—Acknowledging the right of birthright citizenship established by section 1 of the 14th 11 amendment to the Constitution, a person born in the 12 13 United States shall be considered 'subject to the jurisdiction' of the United States for purposes of subsection (a)(1)14 if the person is born in the United States of parents, one 15 of whom is— 16 17 "(1) a citizen or national of the United States;

18 "(2) an alien lawfully admitted for permanent
19 residence in the United States whose residence is in
20 the United States; or

"(3) an alien performing active service in the
 armed forces (as defined in section 101 of title 10,
 United States Code).".

4 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub5 section (a)(3) shall not be construed to affect the citizen6 ship or nationality status of any person born before the
7 date of the enactment of this Act.
