

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 185**  
**OFFERED BY MR. HIGGINS OF NEW YORK**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 **SECTION 1. TERMINATING REQUIREMENT FOR PROOF OF**  
2 **COVID-19 VACCINATION FOR FOREIGN PER-**  
3 **SONS ENTERING ALONG UNITED STATES-**  
4 **CANADA BORDER.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on the date of the en-  
6 actment of this Act, the vaccination requirement for proc-  
7 essing foreign travelers entering at land points of entry,  
8 including ferry terminals, along the along the United  
9 States-Canada border shall have no force or effect.

10 (b) PROHIBITION ON FUNDING.—Beginning on the  
11 date of the enactment of this Act, no Federal funds may  
12 be used to administer, implement, or enforce the vaccina-  
13 tion requirement for processing foreign travelers entering  
14 at land points of entry, including ferry terminals, along  
15 the United States-Canada border.

16 (c) VACCINATION REQUIREMENT FOR FOREIGN  
17 TRAVELERS ENTERING ALONG THE UNITED STATES-  
18 CANADA BORDER.—In this section, the term “vaccination  
19 requirement for processing foreign travelers entering at

1 land points of entry, including ferry terminals, along the  
2 United States-Canada border” refers to the requirement  
3 specified in—

4 (1) the decision issued by the Secretary of  
5 Homeland Security and the Commissioner for U.S.  
6 Customs and Border Protection entitled “Notifica-  
7 tion of Temporary Travel Restrictions Applicable to  
8 Land Ports of Entry and Ferries Service Between  
9 the United States and Canada” and published in the  
10 Federal Register on April 22, 2022 (87 Fed. Reg.  
11 24048 et seq.) for proof of COVID–19 vaccination  
12 for travelers who are covered individuals (as defined  
13 in such order); or

14 (2) any successor or subsequent order of the  
15 Secretary of Homeland Security or the Commis-  
16 sioner for U.S. Customs and Border Protection for  
17 the processing for entry into the United States for-  
18 eign persons to show proof of COVID–19 vaccina-  
19 tion as a condition on entering the United States,  
20 unless determined necessary by Congress.
