Add at the end of title I the following:

. PROPERTY ACQUISITION.

2	(a) In General.—In requiring or acquiring an inter-
3	est in land, the Secretary shall, in accordance with the
4	Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisi-

- 5 tion Policies Act of 1970, prefer the minimum interest in
- 6 real property necessary to support a project or action.
- 7 (b) Determination.—In determining the proper in-
- 8 terest in land under subsection (a), the Secretary shall
- 9 first consider a temporary easement estate or other inter-
- 10 est designed to reduce the overall cost, reduce the time,
- 11 and minimize conflict with property owners related to such
- 12 action or project.
- 13 (c) Procedures Used in State.—The Secretary
- 14 shall consider and attempt to replicate, to the maximum
- 15 extent practicable and consistent with Federal laws, the
- 16 procedures that a State has used to acquire interests in
- 17 land, provided that such procedures are generally con-
- 18 sistent with the goals of a project or action.
