**OFFERED BY MR. HILL OF ARKANSAS**

At the end of title IV, add the following:

1   **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . ENSURING CONTINUED ACCESS TO NON-OPIOID**  
2                           **TREATMENTS FOR PAIN RELIEF.**

3           (a) OUTPATIENT HOSPITAL PROSPECTIVE PAYMENT  
4   SYSTEM.—Section 1833(t) of the Social Security Act (42  
5   U.S.C. 1395l(t)) is amended—

6                   (1) in paragraph (2)(E), by striking “tem-  
7           porary” before “additional payments”;

8                   (2) in paragraph (16)(G), in the subparagraph  
9           heading, by striking “TEMPORARY ADDITIONAL PAY-  
10          MENTS” and inserting “ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS”;

11                  (3) in paragraph (16)(G)(i), by striking “and  
12          before January 1, 2028,”; and

13                  (4) in paragraph (16)(G)(iv)—

14                           (A) in subclause (III), by striking “and” at  
15           the end;

16                           (B) in subclause (IV), by striking the pe-  
17           riod at the end and inserting “; and”; and

18                           (C) by adding at the end the following:

1                   “(V) in the case of a drug or bio-  
2                   logical product, has a label indication  
3                   to reduce acute or post-operative pain,  
4                   or produce postsurgical or regional  
5                   analgesia, without acting upon the  
6                   body’s opioid receptors.”.

7           (b) AMBULATORY SURGICAL CENTER PAYMENT SYS-  
8   TEM.—Section 1833(i) of the Social Security Act (42  
9   U.S.C. 1395l(i)) is amended—

10           (1) in paragraph (10), in the paragraph head-  
11   ing, by striking “TEMPORARY ADDITIONAL PAY-  
12   MENTS” and inserting “ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS”;  
13   and

14           (2) in paragraph (10)(A), by striking “and be-  
15   fore January 1, 2028,”.
