

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4909
(RULES COMM. PRINT 114-53)
OFFERED BY MR. HILL OF ARKANSAS

Add at the end of subtitle F of title X the following
new section:

1 **SEC. 10__ . REQUIRING ASSESSMENT AND GAO REVIEW**
2 **PRIOR TO RELOCATION OF ARMY NATIONAL**
3 **GUARD NETWORK OPERATIONS SUPPORT**
4 **CENTER.**

5 (a) ASSESSMENT.—The Secretary of the Army shall
6 submit to the congressional defense committees an assess-
7 ment of the costs and benefits of the proposed relocation
8 of the Network Operations Support Center of the Army
9 National Guard, and shall include in the assessment each
10 of the following elements:

11 (1) An assessment of the national security ben-
12 efits and any other expected benefits of the proposed
13 relocation, including benefits for the facilities to
14 which the Network Operations Support Center will
15 be relocated.

16 (2) An assessment of the costs of the proposed
17 relocation, including the impact of the proposed relo-

1 cation on the facilities from which the Network Op-
2 erations Support Center will be relocated.

3 (3) Any efficiencies or cost savings that would
4 be achieved by relocating the Network Operations
5 Support Center to the National Guard Professional
6 Education Center located at Camp Robinson in
7 North Little Rock, Arkansas.

8 (4) Any efficiencies or cost savings that would
9 be achieved by relocating the Network Operations
10 Support Center to the Army National Guard Readiness
11 Center located in Arlington, Virginia.

12 (b) REVIEW OF ASSESSMENT BY COMPTROLLER
13 GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the Secretary
14 of the Army submits the assessment under subsection (a),
15 the Comptroller General of the United States shall submit
16 to the congressional defense committees a review of the
17 sufficiency of the assessment, and shall include in the re-
18 view such findings and recommendations as the Comp-
19 troller General considers appropriate.

20 (c) DELAYING RELOCATION UNTIL ASSESSMENT
21 AND REVIEW.—The Secretary of the Army may not relo-
22 cate the Network Operations Support Center of the Army
23 National Guard until the expiration of the 60-day period
24 which begins on the date the Comptroller General of the
