At the end of subtitle C of title XVII, add the following:

## 1 SEC. 17\_. SPACE COOPERATION WITH TAIWAN.

2 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Not later than 90 days after the 3 date of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator of 4 the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, in co-5 ordination with the Secretary of Commerce, acting through the Administrator of the National Oceanic and 6 Atmospheric Administration, and the Secretary of State, 7 8 shall seek to engage Taiwan relating to expanding co-9 operation regarding civilian space activities.

10 (b) COOPERATION EFFORTS.—In seeking to expand 11 the cooperation regarding civilian space activities between 12 the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, and 13 Taiwan under subsection (a), the Administrator of the Na-14 tional Aeronautics and Space Administration and the Ad-15 16 ministrator of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, may carry out efforts to identify and pursue 17 space exploration, space applications, and science initia-18 tives in areas of mutual benefit, consistent with the Tai-19

wan Relations Act of 1979 and applicable export regula tions, and taking all appropriate measures to protect sen sitive information, intellectual property, trade secrets, and
 economic interests of the United States, in the following
 areas:

6 (1) Satellite programs, space exploration pro7 grams, and atmospheric and weather programs.

8 (2) Personnel exchanges of employees of the
9 National Aeronautics and Space Administration and
10 the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administra11 tion with the Taiwan Space Agency.

12 (3) Activities of mutual benefit related to com13 mercial space and atmospheric and weather tech14 nology and services.

15 (c) REPORT.—

16 (1) REQUIREMENT.—Not later than 270 days 17 after the date of the enactment of this Act and an-18 nually thereafter for five years, the Administrator of 19 the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, 20 the Administrator of the National Oceanic and At-21 mospheric Administration, and the Secretary of 22 State, shall submit to the appropriate congressional 23 committees a report on the implementation of this section. 24

(2) the Committee on Commerce, Science, and
 Transportation and the Committee on Foreign Rela tions of the Senate.
