3 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The President is authorized to

7 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS ON MATTERS COVERED BY
8 MEMORANDUM.—It is the sense of Congress that a memo9 randum of understanding in accordance with subsection

- (1) extend to topics such as intelligence sharing, cyber cooperation, military training, arms transfers, defense institutional capacity building, and potential use of authority granted by the Ukraine Democracy Defense Lend-Lease Act of 2022 (Public

(4) include a clause giving Congress oversight.
(c) REPORT.—The President shall regularly report to
Congress with respect to, as applicable—
(1) progress towards negotiating a memo-
randum of understanding in accordance with this
section;
(2) progress towards the adoption of a memo-
randum of understanding so negotiated; and
(3) progress in implementing such memo-
randum of understanding after adoption.
(d) SUNSET.—The authority provided by subsection
