

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT

OFFERED BY MRS. HOUCHIN OF INDIANA

At the end of subtitle B of title III, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 3___. REPORT ON PFAS DESTRUCTION AND WATER**
2 **RECLAMATION.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than June 1, 2027, the Sec-
4 retary of Defense shall submit to the congressional defense
5 committees a report on available technology that leverages
6 recent developments in single-pass high PFAS-destruction
7 technology in water.

8 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report described in subsection
9 (a) shall include the following:

10 (1) A list and a description of available tech-
11 nology that allows—

12 (A) an air-water interface to serve as the
13 primary heat transfer surface; and

14 (B) for the core operating temperature to
15 enable single-pass high PFAS-destruction tech-
16 nology to ensure rapid destruction of per- and
17 polyfluoroalkyl substances in water.

1 (2) A proposal to establish a pilot program
2 under which single-pass high PFAS destruction
3 technology shall be tested for Department of De-
4 fense uses.

5 (3) A list of potential locations that could host
6 such a pilot program.

7 (4) Any other matters the Secretary determines
8 relevant.

9 (c) SINGLE-PASS HIGH PFAS-DESTRUCTION TECH-
10 NOLOGY DEFINED.—In this section, the term “single-pass
11 high PFAS-destruction technology” means a technology
12 that—

13 (1) destroys per- and polyfluoroalkyl sub-
14 stances;

15 (2) is portable and able to operate in remote
16 areas; and

17 (3) can process up to 20,000 gallons of water
18 per day.
