AMENDMENT TO H.R. 27 OFFERED BY MS. HOULAHAN OF PENNSYLVANIA

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1	SEC STUDY ON THE DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINIS-
2	TRATION AND THE NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE
3	PROGRAM.
4	(a) Study.—The Director of National Intelligence,
5	in consultation with the Counternarcotics Executive and
6	the Administrator of the Drug Enforcement Administra-
7	tion, shall conduct a study that—
8	(1) assesses the feasibility and advisability of
9	including all or some of the entities within the Drug
10	Enforcement Administration that conduct intel-
11	ligence-related activities, such as the Special Oper-
12	ations Division and sections of the Intelligence Divi-
13	sion other than the Office of National Security Intel-
14	ligence in the intelligence community (as such term
15	is defined in section 3(4)(L) of the National Secu-
16	rity Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3003(4)(L))); and
17	(2) addresses the potential benefits, risks, and
18	opportunities associated with any such addition in
19	facilitating intelligence-led disruptive activities of the
20	Drug Enforcement Administration, including the po-

- 1 tential benefits of enabling enhanced information
- 2 sharing between the Drug Enforcement Administra-
- 3 tion and the intelligence community.
- 4 (b) REPORT.—Not later than September 1, 2025, the
- 5 Director of National Intelligence, in consultation with the
- 6 Counternarcotics Executive and the Administrator of the
- 7 Drug Enforcement Administration, shall submit to the
- 8 congressional intelligence committees, a report containing
- 9 the findings of the study conducted under subsection (a).
- 10 (c) Funding.—This section shall be carried out
- 11 using amounts otherwise appropriated or made available
- 12 to the National Intelligence Program. No additional funds
- 13 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section.
