

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-**

**OFFERED BY MS. HOULAHAN OF PENNSYLVANIA**

At the end of subtitle E of title X, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 10\_\_\_. REQUIREMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH USE OF**  
2 **PERSONNEL OTHER THAN THE MILITIA OR**  
3 **THE ARMED FORCES TO SUPPRESS INTER-**  
4 **ERENCE WITH STATE AND FEDERAL LAW.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 253 of title 10, United  
6 States Code, is amended—

7 (1) by inserting “(a) IN GENERAL.—” before  
8 “The President”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
10 section:

11 “(b) USE OF OTHER MEANS.—(1) Other means used  
12 by the President pursuant to subsection (a) may only in-  
13 clude activities by Federal law enforcement officers.

14 “(2) Any Federal law enforcement officer performing  
15 duty pursuant to subsection (a) shall visibly display on the  
16 uniform or other clothing of such officer—

17 “(A) the name of such officer; and

1           “(B) the name of the agency for which such of-  
2           ficer is employed.

3           “(3) In this subsection:

4           “(A) The term ‘Federal law enforcement offi-  
5           cer’ means—

6                   “(i) an employee or officer in a position in  
7                   the executive, legislative, or judicial branch of  
8                   the Federal Government who—

9                           “(I) is authorized by law to engage in  
10                           or supervise a law enforcement function; or

11                           “(II) has statutory powers of arrest or  
12                           apprehension under section 807(b) of this  
13                           title (article 7(b) of the Uniform Code of  
14                           Military Justice); or

15                           “(ii) an employee or officer of a contractor  
16                           or subcontractor (at any tier) of an agency in  
17                           the executive, legislative, or judicial branch of  
18                           the Federal Government who is authorized by  
19                           law or under the contract with the agency to  
20                           engage in or supervise a law enforcement func-  
21                           tion; and

22                           “(B) The term ‘law enforcement function’  
23                           means the prevention, detection, or investigation of,  
24                           or the prosecution or incarceration of any person  
25                           for, any violation of law.”.

1 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-  
2 tion, or the amendments made by this section, shall be  
3 construed to limit or otherwise supersede the authority of  
4 Federal law enforcement officials who do not wear a uni-  
5 form in the regular performance of their official duties or  
6 who are engaged in undercover operations to perform their  
7 official duties under authorities other than section 253 of  
8 title 10, United States Code.
