

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-

23

OFFERED BY MS. HOULAHAN OF PENNSYLVANIA

Add at the end of the bill the following:

1 **SEC. 3. OFFICE FOR THE PREVENTION OF FRAUD TAR-**
2 **GETING SENIORS REPORT.**

3 Not later than one year after the date of enactment
4 of this Act, the Federal Trade Commission, acting through
5 the Office for the Prevention of Fraud Targeting Seniors
6 (referred to in this section as the “Office”) established
7 under section 122 of the Seniors Fraud Prevention Act
8 of 2022 shall include, in its annual report to Congress on
9 protecting older adults, the following:

10 (1) A summary of any official or unofficial ad-
11 vice provided by the Office to the Federal Trade
12 Commission to prevent social security fraud tar-
13 geting seniors since the establishment of the Office.

14 (2) A summary of the Office’s oversight actions
15 described in subsection (a)(1) of such section 122
16 and any subsequent findings regarding social secu-
17 rity fraud targeting seniors since the establishment
18 of the Office, including the number of social security
19 fraud cases targeting seniors identified for each

1 year, the breakdown of the social security fraud
2 cases targeting seniors by types of fraud (mail, tele-
3 vision, internet, telemarketing, and robocall) for
4 each year, the estimated total number of seniors im-
5 pacted by social security fraud cases targeting sen-
6 iors for each year, and the estimated total amount
7 of money lost by seniors as a result of social security
8 fraud for each year.

9 (3) The number of complaints for each year
10 logged and acknowledged pursuant to subsection
11 (a)(3)(A) of such section 122, which complaints were
12 made by individuals who believe they have been a
13 victim of social security fraud, broken down by type
14 of fraud (mail, television, internet, telemarketing,
15 and robocall).
