At the appropriate place in subtitle E of title XII, insert the following:

1	SEC PROHIBITION ON SUPPORT OR MILITARY PAR-
2	TICIPATION AGAINST THE HOUTHIS.
3	(a) Prohibition Relating to Support.—In the
4	event that the Saudi-led coalition resumes aerial hostilities
5	against the Houthis in Yemen, none of the funds author-
6	ized to be appropriated or otherwise made available by this
7	Act may be made available to provide the following forms
8	of United States support to such coalition's operations
9	against the Houthis in Yemen:
10	(1) Sharing intelligence for the purpose of ena-
11	bling offensive coalition strikes.
12	(2) Providing logistical support for coalition
13	strikes, including by providing maintenance or trans-
14	ferring spare parts to coalition members flying war-
15	planes engaged in anti-Houthi bombings.
16	(b) Prohibition Relating to Military Partici-
17	PATION.—None of the funds authorized to be appropriated
18	or otherwise made available by this Act may be made

- 1 available for any civilian or military personnel of the De-
- 2 partment of Defense to command, coordinate, participate
- 3 in the movement of, or accompany the regular or irregular
- 4 military forces of the Saudi and United Arab Emirates-
- 5 led coalition forces in hostilities against the Houthis in
- 6 Yemen or in situations in which there exists an imminent
- 7 threat that such coalition forces become engaged in such
- 8 hostilities, unless and until the President has obtained
- 9 specific statutory authorization, in accordance with section
- 10 8(a) of the War Powers Resolution (50 U.S.C. 1547(a)).
- 11 (c) Rule of Construction.—The prohibitions
- 12 under this section may not be construed to apply with re-
- 13 spect to United States Armed Forces engaged in oper-
- 14 ations directed at al Qaeda or associated forces.
