

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4
OFFERED BY MR. DAVIDSON OF OHIO

Page 66, after line 6, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 18. PREVENTION OF CONGRESSIONAL REAPPORTION-**
2 **MENT DISTORTIONS.**

3 (a) ADJUSTMENTS TO PREVENT DISTORTIONS.—

4 Section 141 of title 13, United States Code, is amended—

5 (1) by redesignating subsection (g) as sub-
6 section (h); and

7 (2) by inserting after subsection (f) the fol-
8 lowing:

9 “(g) The Secretary shall make such adjustments in
10 total population figures as may be necessary, using such
11 methods and procedures as the Secretary determines fea-
12 sible and appropriate, in order that those who are not
13 United States citizens are not counted in tabulating popu-
14 lation under subsection (b) for the purposes of appor-
15 tionment of Representatives in Congress among the several
16 States. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to
17 supersede section 195 of this title.”.

18 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 22(a) of
19 the Act entitled “An Act To provide for the fifteenth and
20 subsequent decennial censuses and to provide for appor-

1 tionment of Representatives in Congress”, of June 18,
2 1929 (2 U.S.C. 2a(a)), is amended by striking “as
3 ascertained under the seventeenth and each subsequent
4 decennial census of the population” and inserting “as
5 ascertained and reported under section 141 of title 13,
6 United States Code, for each decennial census of popu-
7 lation”.
