Add at the end of subtitle A of title I the following:

PART 8—PROVIDING VOTER REGISTRATION IN FORMATION TO SECONDARY SCHOOL STU DENTS

4 SEC. 1081. PILOT PROGRAM FOR PROVIDING VOTER REG-

5 ISTRATION INFORMATION TO SECONDARY 6 SCHOOL STUDENTS PRIOR TO GRADUATION.

7 (a) PILOT PROGRAM.—The Election Assistance Commission (hereafter in this part referred to as the "Commis-8 9 sion") shall carry out a pilot program under which the 10 Commission shall provide funds during the one-year period 11 beginning after the date of the enactment of this part to 12 eligible local educational agencies for initiatives to provide information on registering to vote in elections for public 13 14 office to secondary school students in the 12th grade.

(b) ELIGIBILITY.—A local educational agency is eligible to receive funds under the pilot program under this
part if the agency submits to the Commission, at such
time and in such form as the Commission may require,
an application containing—

(1) a description of the initiatives the agency
 intends to carry out with the funds;

3 (2) an estimate of the costs associated with
4 such initiatives; and

5 (3) such other information and assurances as6 the Commission may require.

7 (c) CONSULTATION WITH ELECTION OFFICIALS.—A 8 local educational agency receiving funds under the pilot 9 program shall consult with the State and local election of-10 ficials who are responsible for administering elections for public office in the area served by the agency in developing 11 the initiatives the agency will carry out with the funds. 12 13 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this part, the terms "local educational agency" and "secondary school" have the 14 15 meanings given such terms in section 8101 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 16 7801). 17

18 SEC. 1082. REPORTS.

(a) REPORTS BY RECIPIENTS OF FUNDS.—Not later
than the expiration of the 90-day period which begins on
the date of the receipt of the funds, each local educational
agency receiving funds under the pilot program under this
part shall submit a report to the Commission describing
the initiatives carried out with the funds and analyzing
their effectiveness.

(b) REPORT BY COMMISSION.—Not later than the ex piration of the 60-day period which begins on the date
 the Commission receives the final report submitted by a
 local educational agency under subsection (a), the Com mission shall submit a report to Congress on the pilot pro gram under this part.

7 SEC. 1083. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

8 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums9 as may be necessary to carry out this part.
