7 sonnel, Army”, for necessary expenses to respond to the
8 significant rise in unaccompanied minors and family unit
9 aliens at the southwest border and related activities,
10 \$172,056,000: *Provided*, That such amount is designated
11 by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant
12 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and
13 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

15 **OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, ARMY**

16 For an additional amount for “Operation and Main-
17 tenance, Army” for necessary expenses to respond to the
18 significant rise in unaccompanied minors and family unit
19 aliens at the southwest border and related activities,
20 \$135,603,000: *Provided*, That such amount is designated

1 by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant
2 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and
3 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

4 OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, MARINE CORPS

5 For an additional amount for “Operation and Main-
6 tenance, Marine Corps” for necessary expenses to respond
7 to the significant rise in unaccompanied minors and family
8 unit aliens at the southwest border and related activities,
9 \$13,025,000: *Provided*, That such amount is designated
10 by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant
11 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and
12 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

13 OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, AIR FORCE

14 For an additional amount for “Operation and Main-
15 tenance, Air Force” for necessary expenses to respond to
16 the significant rise in unaccompanied minors and family
17 unit aliens at the southwest border and related activities,
18 \$35,372,000: *Provided*, That such amount is designated
19 by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant
20 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and
21 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

22 OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, ARMY NATIONAL GUARD

23 For an additional amount for “Operation and Main-
24 tenance, Army National Guard” for necessary expenses to
25 respond to the significant rise in unaccompanied minors

1 and family unit aliens at the southwest border and related
2 activities, \$21,024,000: *Provided*, That such amount is
3 designated by the Congress as an emergency requirement
4 pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budg-
5 et and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

10 For an additional amount for “Refugee and Entrant

12 able for the same period as funds appropriated in Public
13 Law 115-245 for carrying out section 414 of the Immigra-
14 tion and Nationality Act, section 501 of the Refugee Edu-
15 cation Assistance Act of 1980, section 462 of the Home-
16 land Security Act of 2002, and section 235 of the William
17 Wilberforce Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthoriza-
18 tion Act of 2008: *Provided*, That such amount is des-
19 igned by the Congress as an emergency requirement
20 pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budg-
21 et and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

2 SECURITY, ENFORCEMENT, AND BORDER PROTECTION
3 U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION
4 OPERATIONS AND SUPPORT

5 For an additional amount for “Operations and Sup-
6 port” for necessary expenses to respond to the significant
7 rise in unaccompanied minors and family unit aliens at
8 the southwest border and related activities, \$479,528,000;
9 of which \$190,000,000 shall be available until September
10 30, 2020: *Provided*, That such amount is designated by
11 the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant to
12 section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and
13 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

14 PROCUREMENT, CONSTRUCTION, AND IMPROVEMENTS
15 For an additional amount for “Procurement, Con-
16 struction, and Improvements” for necessary expenses to
17 respond to the significant rise in unaccompanied minors
18 and family unit aliens at the southwest border and related
19 activities, \$85,000,000, to remain available until Sep-
20 tember 30, 2023: *Provided*, That such amount is des-
21 ignated by the Congress as an emergency requirement
22 pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budg-
23 et and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

1 U.S. IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT
2 OPERATIONS AND SUPPORT

3 For an additional amount for “Operations and Sup-
4 port” for necessary expenses to respond to the significant
5 rise in unaccompanied minors and family unit aliens at
6 the southwest border and related activities, and for the
7 necessary expenses for enforcement of immigration and
8 customs laws, detention and removals of aliens crossing
9 the border unlawfully, and investigations, \$534,566,000;
10 of which \$81,723,611 shall be available until September
11 30, 2020: *Provided*, That such amount is designated by
12 the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant to
13 section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and
14 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

15 DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

16 UNITED STATES MARSHALS SERVICE

17 FEDERAL PRISONER DETENTION

18 For an additional amount for “Federal Prisoner De-
19 tention”, \$155,000,00: *Provided*, That such amount is
20 designated by the Congress as an emergency requirement
21 pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budg-
22 et and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.
