## AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT FOR H.R. 4681

## OFFERED BY MR. PITTS OF PENNSYLVANIA

At the end of subtitle B of title III, insert the following:

## 1SEC. 329. ANNUAL REPORT ON TARGETED LETHAL FORCE2TRANSPARENCY.

3 (a) REQUIREMENT FOR ANNUAL REPORT.—Not later 4 than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, 5 and once every calendar year thereafter, the Director of National Intelligence shall submit to the congressional in-6 telligence committees and the Committees on Armed Serv-7 ices of the House of Representatives and the Senate and 8 9 make publicly available a annual report on the use of targeted lethal force by remotely-piloted aircraft. Except as 10 11 provided under subsection (b), each such report shall include each of the following for the year covered by the 12 13 report:

(1) The total number of individuals assessed as
combatants killed or injured in armed conflict during the year by the use of targeted lethal force outside the United States by remotely-piloted aircraft.

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(2) The total number of individuals assessed as
 civilians killed or injured in armed conflict during
 the year by the use of targeted lethal force outside
 the United States by remotely-piloted aircraft.

(3) The total number of persons killed or injured during the year by the use of targeted lethal
force outside the United States by remotely-piloted
aircraft who are not included in the totals reported
under paragraph (1) or (2).

10 (4) The definitions of the terms "combatant"11 and "civilian" used for purposes of such report.

(b) EXCEPTION.—A report required by subsection (a)
shall not include any use of targeted lethal force in a foreign country described by a future declaration of war or
authorization for the use of military force.

16 (c) DIRECTOR OF NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE RE-PORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the en-17 18 actment of this Act, and once every calendar year there-19 after, the Director of National Intelligence, in consultation 20 with the Secretary of Defense, shall submit to the congres-21 sional intelligence committees and the Committees on 22 Armed Services of the House of Representatives and the 23 Senate a report on—

24 (1) civilian protection mechanisms in armed25 conflict in accordance with international law, includ-

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ing civilian casualty mitigation processes and post strike investigatory procedures;

3 (2) the methodology used to distinguish com4 batants from civilians in armed conflict prior to
5 armed operations and after a strike has occurred;
6 and

7 (3) processes for recognizing the immediate and
8 long-term effects of drones strikes on the organiza9 tion being targeted and on the country or region in
10 which the strike takes place.

(d) SUBMITTAL OF LEGAL OPINIONS TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 60 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, and once every six months thereafter,
the Director of National Intelligence shall submit to Congress all legal opinions providing advice regarding the authority to use targeted lethal force by remotely-piloted aircraft to justify operations.

(e) FORM OF REPORTS.—The reports required under
subsections (a), (c) and (d) shall be submitted or provided
in classified form, but shall include an unclassified summary. The unclassified summaries shall be made public.
(f) TARGETED LETHAL FORCE DEFINED.—In this
section, the term "targeted lethal force" means the act

1 of directing lethal force at a particular person or group

2 with the specific intent of killing such person or group.

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
