

Goal: advance reforms to SNAP that better align the program with its central purpose of providing nutritional assistance that promotes improved nutrition and healthier lifestyles

Amendment: SNAP Data Collection and Transparency

- Require the Secretary of Agriculture to conduct and publish an annual survey, with data including:
 - Distribution of household expenditures by major food groups and by store type (e.g., convenience stores, gas stations, large retailers, small grocers)
 - Seasonal consumption patterns
 - Variation in consumption by household size
- Require USDA to report to Congress (e.g., annually or semiannually) on:
 - Diet quality and health outcomes among SNAP participants
 - Changes in purchasing behavior
 - Effectiveness of any nutrition-related restrictions and/or incentives
 - Any observed impacts on fraud/program integrity
