

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT  
FOR H.R. 399  
OFFERED BY MR. HUDSON OF NORTH CAROLINA**

In section 3(c), strike paragraphs (1) and (2) and insert the following:

1           (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 18 months  
2           after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-  
3           retary of Homeland Security shall take all actions  
4           the Secretary determines necessary and appropriate  
5           to achieve and maintain operational control over the  
6           entire international land and maritime borders of  
7           the United States, to include the following—

8                   (A) systematic surveillance of the inter-  
9                   national land and maritime borders of the  
10                  United States through more effective use of  
11                  personnel and technology, such as unmanned  
12                  aerial vehicles, ground-based sensors, satellites,  
13                  radar coverage, and cameras; and

14                  (B) physical infrastructure enhancements  
15                  to prevent unlawful entry by aliens into the  
16                  United States and facilitate access to the inter-  
17                  national land and maritime borders by United  
18                  States Customs and Border Protection, such as

1 additional checkpoints, all weather access roads,  
2 and vehicle barriers.

3 (2) OPERATIONAL CONTROL DEFINED.—In  
4 paragraph (1), the term “operational control” means  
5 the prevention of all unlawful entries into the United  
6 States, including entries by terrorists, other unlawful  
7 aliens, instruments of terrorism, narcotics, and other  
8 contraband.
