10	2026, the Secretary of Defense, acting through the
11	Assistant Secretary of Defense for Nuclear, Chem-
12	ical, and Biological Defense Programs, shall trans-
13	mit to the Congress a report on whether to expand
14	the Material Threat Medical Countermeasure Pri-
15	ority Review Voucher Program under section 565A
16	of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21
17	U.S.C. 360bbb-4a) to include additional classes and
18	categories of drugs that are identified as necessary

1	to prevent or treat diseases and conditions caused by
2	a chemical, biological, radiological, or nuclear agent.
3	(2) Contents.—The report under paragraph
4	(A) shall include an assessment of—
5	(A) threats that have the potential to lead
6	to a public health emergency with significant
7	potential to affect national security; and
8	(B) threats that may present a specific
9	threat to the Armed Forces and readiness.
