United States Armed Forces' equipment and oper-1 2 ational tactics, techniques, and products through 3 interaction with the militaries of United States allies and partners; and 4 (2) an identification of any obstacles to ensur-5 6 ing United States allies and partners are sufficiently aware of the risk described in paragraph (1) and on 7 conducting the necessary follow-up and end-use 8 monitoring to ensure compliance by such allies and 9 10 partners.
