## OFFERED BY MR. GALLAGHER OF WISCONSIN

At the end of subtitle E of title XII, add the following new section:

6 (a) LIMITATION.—Of the funds authorized to be appropriated by this Act or otherwise made available for fis-7 8 cal year 2024, and available for the Office of the Secretary 9 of Defense for the travel of persons, not more than 90 10 percent may be obligated or expended until the date on 11 which the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and 12 Sustainment submits to the congressional defense commit-13 tees the plan required under subsection (b).

14 (b) PLAN REQUIRED.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and
Sustainment shall develop and implement a plan to

3	tion 506 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 $$

5	(2) ELEMENTS.—The plan under paragraph (1)
6	shall address the following:
7	(A) Lessons learned from any similar expe-
8	riences in support of military forces of security
9	partners in 2022.
10	(B) Consultation with private industry.
11	(C) Use of existing ground-based launch-
12	ers.
13	(D) Use of existing vehicles of the Federal
14	Government.
15	(E) Integration and modernization of re-
16	quired systems.
17	(F) Any security risks, challenges, and
18	mitigation steps required.
19	(G) Expected costs.
20	(H) A timeline for the delivery of covered
21	Harpoon missiles to security partners.
22	(3) SUBMITTAL TO CONGRESS.—Not later than
23	180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act,
24	the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and
25	Sustainment, shall submit to the congressional de-

fense committees the plan required under paragraph
 (1).

3 (c) COVERED HARPOON MISSILE DEFINED.—In this 4 section, the term "covered Harpoon missile" means a 5 block IC Harpoon missile designated with a "sundown", 6 "deep stow", or "demilitarized" condition code and in-7 cludes missiles with that designation that have been re-8 moved from surface vessels of the Navy.
