

**AMENDMENT TO H. RES. 676, AS REPORTED**

**OFFERED BY M**     .

In the first section of the resolution—

(1) strike “That the Speaker” and insert “That  
(a) The Speaker”;

(2) strike “or any other related provision of  
law,” and

(3) add at the end the following new sub-  
sections:

1 (b) For purposes of subsection (a), the term “officer  
2 or employee of the executive branch” does not include any  
3 of the following individuals:

4 (1) A member of the armed forces (as defined  
5 in section 101(a)(4) of title 10, United States Code).

6 (2) A veteran (as defined in section 101 of title  
7 38, United States Code).

8 (3) Any officer or employee of the executive  
9 branch who is not a senior employee. For purposes  
10 of this paragraph, the term “senior employee”  
11 means a covered executive branch official under sec-  
12 tion 3(3) of the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 (2  
13 U.S.C. 1602(3)).

1 (c)(1) No civil action initiated, or in which the House  
2 intervenes, pursuant to this resolution may have as its  
3 subject any of the provisions of law described in paragraph  
4 (2).

5 (2) The provisions of law described in this paragraph  
6 are as follows:

7 (A) COVERAGE OF ADULT CHILDREN UNTIL  
8 AGE 26.—Section 2714 of the Public Health Service  
9 Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg–14), relating to the extension  
10 of dependent coverage for adult children until age  
11 18.

12 (B) PREVENTIVE HEALTH SERVICES.—Section  
13 2713 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.  
14 300gg–13), relating to the coverage of preventive  
15 health services without cost sharing, including well-  
16 woman preventive care visits, breast cancer screen-  
17 ing, mammography, screening for gestational diabe-  
18 tes, and screening for interpersonal and domestic vi-  
19 olence.

20 (C) PROHIBITION OF PREEXISTING CONDITION  
21 EXCLUSIONS.—Section 2704 of the Public Health  
22 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg–3), relating to the  
23 prohibition of preexisting condition exclusions or  
24 other discrimination based on health status.

1           (D) SMALL BUSINESS TAX CREDITS.—Section  
2           45R of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, relating  
3           to small employer health insurance credits.

4           (E) CLOSURE OF MEDICARE PART D DONUT  
5           HOLE.—Section 1860D–14A of the Social Security  
6           Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w–114a), relating to the Medi-  
7           care part D coverage gap discount program.
