## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118– 36

## OFFERED BY MR. SCHNEIDER OF ILLINOIS

At the end of subtitle B of title XII, insert the following:

1	SEC. 12 HELP ISRAEL RECOVER THE HOSTAGES.
2	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:
3	(1) There has been substantial and sustained
4	cooperation between United States diplomatic, mili-
5	tary, and intelligence agencies and Israeli counter-
6	parts to help Israel release those taken hostage on
7	the attacks of October 7th, 2023.
8	(2) Multiple proposals for returning the hos-
9	tages and implementing a ceasefire have been devel-
10	oped with the help of the United States and inter-
11	national partners and presented to both Israel and
12	Hamas.
13	(3) Hamas has impeded or outright rejected
14	these proposals, refusing to release the hostages and
15	extending the suffering of civilians on both sides of
16	the border.
17	(4) The global community, including the United
18	States, must exert necessary pressure on Hamas

1	leadership to accept a ceasefire proposal, release the
2	hostages and relinquish governing control of Gaza.
3	(5) It is imperative that the United States con-
4	tinues to work with international partners to release
5	the remaining hostages, including 8 Americans.
6	(b) Briefing.—
7	(1) In general.—Not later than 30 days after
8	the date of the enactment of this section, the Sec-
9	retary of Defense, in consultation with the Secretary
10	of State and the Director of National Intelligence
11	shall provide a briefing to the congressional defense
12	committees, the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the
13	House of Representatives, the Committee on Foreign
14	Relations of the Senate, and the House and Senate
15	Permanent Select Committees on Intelligence that
16	contains an overview of United States diplomatic
17	military, and intelligence support for Israel as it
18	works to release the hostages.
19	(2) Contents.—The briefing required under
20	paragraph (1) shall contain the following, relating to
21	supporting the release of the hostages:
22	(A) An overview of United States military
23	assistance to Israel.

1	(B) How the United States military is as-
2	sisting the Israeli military on hostage rescue
3	planning and recovery efforts.
4	(C) Intelligence sharing in support of hos-
5	tage release.
6	(D) United States personnel embedded or
7	regularly liaising with Israel's military, intel-
8	ligence, and diplomatic officials.
9	(E) A description of how the United States
10	is leveraging partner nations to assist with hos-
11	tage release efforts.
12	(F) Any other forms of assistance provided
13	the Secretary determines relevant to Israel's ef-
14	forts to release the hostages.
15	(3) FORM.—The briefing required under para-
16	graph (1) shall be provided in unclassified form, but
17	may contain a classified annex.
18	(c) Hostages Defined.—In this section, the term
19	"hostages" means the individuals (alive or deceased) taken
20	by Hamas from Israel during the attacks of October 7,
21	2023, and the immediate aftermath, including Israelis,
22	Americans, and citizens of other more than 22 other na-
23	tions.
