

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MRS. RAMIREZ OF ILLINOIS

Add at the end of subtitle A of title XVII the following:

1 **SEC. 17__ . DISQUALIFICATIONS FROM EMPLOYMENT**
2 **WITH ICE.**

3 (a) CONVICTIONS.—The Secretary of Homeland Se-
4 curity, acting through the Director of U.S. Immigration
5 and Customs Enforcement (ICE), shall ensure an indi-
6 vidual applying to be an ICE agent is subject to a back-
7 ground check and disqualified from employment with ICE
8 if such individual was convicted at any time on a charge
9 of any of the following:

- 10 (1) Hate crimes.
- 11 (2) Terrorism.
- 12 (3) Conspiracy.
- 13 (4) Sedition.
- 14 (5) Murder.
- 15 (6) Obstruction of an official proceeding.
- 16 (7) Weapons offenses.
- 17 (8) Assault and battery.
- 18 (9) Sexual assault.
- 19 (10) Child abuse.

1 (b) OTHER DISQUALIFICATIONS.—The Secretary of
2 Homeland Security, acting through the Director of ICE,
3 shall ensure an individual applying to be an ICE agent
4 is subject to a background check and disqualified from em-
5 ployment with ICE if such individual has an active or past
6 restraining orders or orders of protection.

7 (c) REPORT.—The Secretary of Homeland Security
8 annually submit to Congress a report on the number of
9 individuals disqualified under subsections (a) and (b).
