

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1573, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MR. ISSA OF CALIFORNIA**

Page 7, strike line 11 and all that follows through line 13 on page 7 and insert the following:

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE; CERTIFICATION.—

2           (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by  
3       subsection (a) shall take effect 180 days after the  
4       date of the enactment of this Act.

5           (2) CERTIFICATION.—Notwithstanding the ef-  
6       fective date in paragraph (1), the amendment made  
7       by subsection (a) shall not take effect unless the  
8       Secretary of Homeland Security certifies in writing  
9       to the Chairman and Ranking Member of the Com-  
10      mittees on the Judiciary in the House of Represent-  
11      atives and the Senate that the Department of Home-  
12      land Security—

13           (A) has sufficient resources to accommo-  
14      date, during the secondary inspection process,  
15      the access to counsel and other assistance re-  
16      quirements described in subsection (a); and

17           (B) determines that such requirements will  
18      not cause a substantial negative impact on the

1 facilitation of lawful trade and travel into the  
2 United States.
