(a) In General.—Chapter 57 of title 10, United
States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1130
the following new section:
"§ 1130a. Consideration of proposals for certain deco-

- 4 "(c) Rules of Construction.—(1) The failure of
- 5 the Secretary of a military department to complete the re-
- 6 view of a request under subsection (a)(2) within the time
- 7 limitations under subsection (b) shall not be construed to
- 8 limit the authority to award a decoration under this sec-
- 9 tion.
- 10 "(2) In the case of a decoration the President may
- 11 award, the recommendation of the Secretary of the mili-

- 13 shall not be construed to prohibit the President from

- 15 "(d) Reports.—(1)(A) Not later than 30 days after

11	Secretary to improve award procedures with respect
12	to military intelligence personnel.".
13	(b) Offset From Defense Health Program.—

15	under section 20001(a)(4) of Public Law 119–21 (139
16	Stat. 112), \$3,000,000 are rescinded.
