AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–36

OFFERED BY MR. ISSA OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle C of title XXVIII, add the following new section:

1 SEC. 28____. ACCESS TO MILITARY INSTALLATIONS FOR 2 CERTAIN SURVIVING GOLD STAR FAMILY 3 MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.

4 (a) PROCEDURES FOR ACCESS OF SURVIVING GOLD 5 STAR FAMILY MEMBERS REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Defense, acting jointly with the Secretary of the depart-6 7 ment in which the Coast Guard is operating when it is not operating as a Service in the Navy, shall establish pro-8 9 cedures by which any eligible Surviving Gold Star Family Member of a covered member of the Armed Forces may 10 11 obtain unescorted access, as appropriate, to military in-12 stallations, notwithstanding the purpose of such access.

13 (b) CONSIDERATIONS.—Any procedures established14 under this section shall—

(1) be applied consistently across the Department of Defense and the Secretary of the department in which the Coast Guard is operating when it

1	is not operating as a Service in the Navy, including
2	all components of the Departments;
3	(2) minimize any administrative burden on a
4	Surviving Gold Star Family Member;
5	(3) take into account measures required to en-
6	sure the security of military installations, including
7	eligibility for access, renewal periodicity, and instal-
8	lation commander discretion to temporarily limit ac-
9	cess only as necessary; and
10	(4) take into account such other factors as the
11	Secretary of Defense or the Secretary of the depart-
12	ment in which the Coast Guard is operating when it
13	is not operating as a Service in the Navy considers
14	appropriate.
15	(c) DEADLINE.—The procedures required by sub-
16	section (a) shall be established by the date that is not later
17	than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
18	(d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
19	(1) The term "eligible Surviving Gold Star
20	Family Member'' means an individual who is a
21	widow or widower, parent, grandparent, child, step-
22	child, child through adoption, brother, half-brother,
23	sister, half-sister, or stepsibling of a covered member
24	of the Armed Forces, or other family member as the

Secretary considers appropriate.

(2) The term "covered member of the Armed
 Forces" means a member of the Armed Forces who
 dies while serving—
 (A) on active duty; or

5 (B) on such reserve or National Guard
6 duty as the Secretary of Defense and the Sec7 retary of the department in which the Coast
8 Guard is operating when it is not operating as
9 a Service in the Navy may jointly specify for
10 purposes of this section.
