AMENDMENT TO H.R. 9026, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MR. ISSA OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

SEC. . None of the funds made available by 1 this Act may be used to implement, administer, or enforce 2 3 any prohibition of the installation, maintenance, operation, 4 or retirement of a telecommunications submarine cable 5 within the boundaries of a National Marine Sanctuary, or any associated permitting or regulatory requirement re-6 7 lated thereby; unless and until the Administrator of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, fol-8 9 lowing the effective date of this Act, has completed a cost-10 benefit analysis of the imposition of a National Marine 11 Sanctuary in an active coastal zone with substantial 12 subsea cable investment and infrastructure, subject to 13 public comment, that accurately and holistically analyzes the impact of such prohibition and associated require-14 ments on the submarine cable industry and the associated 15 16 impact on the economy of the United States and governmental and national security interests. Provided that, not-17 withstanding the foregoing, funds made available by this 18 Act may be used for the streamlined and expedited certifi-19

1 cation or authorization, as applicable, under an existing 2 State or Federal authority of a telecommunications submarine cable activity within a National Marine Sanctuary 3 4 that would otherwise be prohibited by part 922 of title 5 15, Code of Federal Regulations, provided that due consideration is given to the reviews of that cable by other 6 7 Federal and State authorities, without duplication of any 8 such reviews or the results thereof, and without additional 9 condition unless demonstrably necessary to protect specific and particularized sanctuary resources or interests not ad-10 11 dressed by such other agency.
