

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–10**  
**OFFERED BY MR. ISSA OF CALIFORNIA**

At the appropriate place in subtitle A of title XVIII,  
insert the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . TERMINATION OF CERTAIN WAIVERS OF SANC-**  
2 **TIONS WITH RESPECT TO NUCLEAR ACTIVI-**  
3 **TIES IN OR WITH IRAN.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Effective on the date of the enact-  
5 ment of this Act, any waiver of the application of sanctions  
6 provided for under sections 1244, 1245, 1246, and 1247  
7 of the Iran Freedom and Counter-Proliferation Act of  
8 2012 (22 U.S.C. 8803, 8804, 8805, and 8806) for or to  
9 enable an activity described in subsection (b) is termi-  
10 nated, and the President may not issue a new such waiver  
11 for such an activity on or after such date of enactment.

12 (b) **ACTIVITIES DESCRIBED.**—An activity described  
13 in this subsection is an activity in or with Iran with re-  
14 spect to which a waiver described in subsection (a) was  
15 issued in connection with the Joint Comprehensive Plan  
16 of Action, including the following:

17 (1) Modernization or redesign of the Arak reac-  
18 tor.

1           (2) Preparation or modification of centrifuge  
2 cascades at the Fordow facility for stable isotope  
3 production.

4           (3) Operations, training, or services related to  
5 the Bushehr Nuclear Power Plant, including fuel de-  
6 livery and take-back.

7           (4) Transfer of uranium into or outside Iran,  
8 including natural uranium, enriched uranium, or nu-  
9 clear fuel scrap.

10          (5) Transfer or storage of Iranian heavy water,  
11 inside or outside of Iran.

12          (c) JOINT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF ACTION DE-  
13 FINED.—In this section, the term “Joint Comprehensive  
14 Plan of Action” means the Joint Comprehensive Plan of  
15 Action signed at Vienna on July 14, 2015, by Iran and  
16 by France, Germany, the Russian Federation, the People’s  
17 Republic of China, the United Kingdom, and the United  
18 States, and all implementing materials and agreements re-  
19 lated to the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action.
