At the end of subtitle C of title XVII, add the following:

1	SEC. 17 DECLASSIFICATION REVIEW AND PUBLICATION
2	OF MATERIALS RELATING TO AFGHANISTAN
3	WITHDRAWAL.
4	(a) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of Con-
5	gress that the American people deserve to understand the
6	events and decision-making which resulted in the chaotic
7	withdrawal of United States personnel from Afghanistan
8	in 2021.
9	(b) Dissent Channel Cable Relating to Af-
10	GHANISTAN WITHDRAWAL.—
11	(1) Submission to congress.—
12	(A) Submission.—Not later than 5 days
13	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
14	Secretary of State shall submit to the Com-
15	mittee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-
16	resentatives and the Committee on Foreign Re-
17	lations of the Senate a complete (and, except as
18	provided in subparagraph (B), unredacted) copy
19	of—

1	(i) the dissent channel cable of the
2	Department of State written on or about
3	July 13, 2021, describing the likely con-
4	sequences of United States withdrawal
5	from Afghanistan; and
6	(ii) the official response of the De-
7	partment of State with respect to such dis-
8	sent channel cable.
9	(B) AUTHORIZED REDACTIONS.—The Sec-
10	retary may redact the name of any signatory to
11	the dissent channel cable specified in subpara-
12	graph (A).
13	(2) Declassification review; publica-
14	TION.—
15	(A) In general.—Not later than 60 days
16	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
17	Secretary of State shall—
18	(i) complete a declassification review
19	to determine what, if any, information con-
20	tained within the dissent channel cable or
21	the official response specified in paragraph
22	(1)(A) may be declassified in accordance
23	with the standards under subsection (d);
24	(ii) declassify any information so de-
25	termined; and

1	(iii) publish on a publicly available
2	internet website of the Department of
3	State such dissent channel cable and offi-
4	cial response, in unclassified form and con-
5	taining, in addition to any information pre-
6	viously unclassified, any other information
7	declassified as a result of such declassifica-
8	tion review.
9	(B) REQUIRED REDACTIONS.—In pub-
10	lishing the dissent channel cable pursuant to
11	subparagraph (A)(iii), the Secretary shall re-
12	dact the name, and any other personally identi-
13	fiable information, of each signatory to such
14	dissent channel cable.
15	(e) Declassification and Publication of
16	AFTER-ACTION REVIEW OF DEPARTMENT OF STATE.—
17	Not later than 60 days after the date of the enactment
18	of this Act, the Secretary of State shall—
19	(1) complete a declassification review to deter-
20	mine what, if any, additional information contained
21	within the after-action review of the Department of
22	State developed with respect to the Afghanistan
23	withdrawal (in this section, referred to as the "after-
24	action review") may be declassified in accordance
25	with the standards under subsection (d);

1	(2) declassify any information so determined;
2	and
3	(3) publish on a publicly available internet
4	website of the Department of State a complete
5	version of such after-action review containing, in ad-
6	dition to information previously unclassified, any
7	other information declassified as a result of such de-
8	classification review.
9	(d) Standards for Declassification.—In con-
10	ducting each declassification review under this section
11	with respect to given information, the Secretary of State
12	shall declassify such information unless the Secretary de-
13	termines the declassification would be incompatible with
14	the national security interests of the United States or oth-
15	erwise inconsistent with the protection of intelligence
16	sources and methods.
